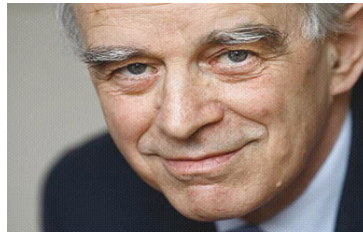

Professor Van Lommel is an internationally renowned and published cardiologist who has over 25 years of experience of teaching and practising. In 2001, Dr. van Lommel and others published their Dutch study in the reputable medical journal *The Lancet*.

He is the first medical practitioner to have undertaken a full, systematic study of near-death experiences (NDEs).

Over the past several years Pim van Lommel has been lecturing all over the world on near-death experiences and the relationship between consciousness and brain function. In 2005, he was granted the ‘*Bruce Greyson Research Award*’ on behalf of the IANDS (the International Association of Near-Death Studies). And, in September 2006, the President of India, Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, awarded him the ‘*Life Time Achievement Award*’ at the World Congress on Clinical and Preventive Cardiology.
